Anderson works with Tim Lear (BMT) to manage the delivery and development of the NSASS framework and associated tasks and takes the lead on those tasks relating to the Naval Ship Code and Naval Ship Rules.

Anderson joined Lloyd's Register EMEA's Naval Liaison Office in 2016 and is responsible for identifying, developing and delivering new products and processes to support UK MoD operations.
